Sydney Motorsport Park managed by the Australian Racing Drivers' Club (ARDC), is committed to sustainability. Our dedication to sustainability has been recognised by the 'Sustainable Circuit Index' 2023 report with an 'Honourable mention' as the most improved circuit and where Sydney Motorsport Park has ranked as the most sustainable motorsport circuit in Australia for the past three years. We understand that live events present an opportunity to create positive social and environmental impacts, benefiting both attendees and the wider community. By prioritising sustainability, we aim to enhance our reputation, attract like-minded attendees, and leave a positive legacy for future generations.

Our current sustainability focuses:

Environmental

- Waste management: Alongside our partner Closed-loop Environmental Services we will actively encourage waste reduction initiatives, design and manage waste streams to ensure all materials have the potential to be recycled as a resource.
- Sustainable procurement: We will prioritise the procurement of environmentally friendly products and services, including compostable or reusable materials, eco-friendly catering options, and energy-efficient equipment.

Social

- **Education and Training:** We will provide innovative education and training solutions in collaboration with ARDC, Sydney Motorsport Park, third-party partners, and tenants to raise awareness and promote sustainable practices.
- Community Engagement: We will actively engage with local communities and stakeholders to understand their needs and concerns, fostering transparent communication and collaboration to build trust and support for our sustainability initiatives.
- **Health and Safety:** We prioritise the health and safety of all participants, spectators, and staff by adhering to safety standards, providing training, and implementing emergency response protocols.

Governance

Hirers responsibilities:

- Proactively collaborate with the ARDC and Closed Loop Environmental Services (CLES) to identify and develop best practice sustainability initiatives as part of event delivery.
- Work with the ARDC and CLES to communicate sustainability initiatives and expectations to third-party event partners, sponsors, race categories, teams, and competitors.
- Provide an environmental plan for the event within 30 days of its conclusion, outlining measures taken to minimise environmental impact.
- Conform to reasonable directives from the ARDC or CLES regarding waste management during the license period.

By partnering with stakeholders, implementing innovative solutions, and promoting a culture of environmental responsibility, we aim to lead by example and inspire positive change within the motorsport industry and beyond.
